

# Rock Crawl Rules

## Overall

All Rock Crawl Classes will be using a point system for scoring. This will be explained at the drivers meetings for each class. No Penalty will be given for on the ground spotter. There will be a 10 minute time limit.

## Modified A Class

This class is open to any vehicle with up to 33 inch Tires. Can not be linked suspension. No Buggies.

## Modified B Class

This class is open to any vehicle with a maximum 35 inch tire Can not be linked suspension. No Buggies.

## Super Modified Class

This class is open to any vehicle with a maximum of 39.5 inch tires and can not be fully linked. No Buggies.

## Unlimited Class

This class is open to any vehicles, any tire size and all Buggies.

## Safety Requirements

Drivers meeting will be held ½ hour prior to the start of each class. All drivers must attend there class meeting. If you miss the meeting you will be disqualified and entry fees forfeited.

All Vehicles must be inspected and approved by the event safety officials before entering the course. Class corrections will be made at that time if necessary. All Decisions of the inspection team are final.

5 MPH speed limit over the entire facility.

A Roll cage or rollover protection is required.

Driver must wear protective head gear and Seat Belts must be worn. **Spotter must wear protective head gear.**

All batteries must be solidly secured. No bungee cords or tie-down straps. All batteries located in the drivers compartment must be securely fastened down and covered.

All vehicles must be able to be towed or pulled from the front or rear in case the vehicle becomes stuck or disabled.

No passengers are allowed.

When the safety official notifies you that time has expired or that you have stopped forward motion for more that 30 seconds, you must immediately stop, put the vehicle in Neutral/Park and wait for the safety official to tell you what to do. Any movement after you have been notified to stop could result in you being disqualified and entry fees forfeited.

Tire size is based on the manufactured tire size that is printed on the sidewall.

Any driver that is suspected of drinking any alcoholic beverage will not be allowed to enter the course.

**All decisions made by the safety officials are final.**
